

Guidance and Counseling

These activities will allow students to plan their further education, study methods, career, and other aspects of living. Students will also be given opportunity to understand what it means to be researchers, inventors, and innovators in the field of mathematics, science and technology.

Moreover, these activities will help to strengthen the bond between students, teachers, and parents so that teachers and parents can develop mutual understanding and participate collectively in giving students appropriate advice.

The overall picture of guidance and counseling activities during the three years at KVIS is shown in table 8.

Table 8: Guidance and counseling activities for 3 years

Activities	Minimum Requirement
1. Field trips to mathematics, science, or technology research centers	6 times (each time for at least 180 minutes)
2. Academic camps	1 time (3 days)
3. Discussions with scientists, researchers, inventors, and innovators in mathematics, science, and technology in Thailand and overseas	6 times (each time for at least 90 minutes)
4. Discussions with experts who are successful in various careers	4 times (each time for at least 90 minutes)
5. Discussions with experts in the field of Personality Development and Emotional Quotient	4 times (each time for at least 90 minutes)
6. Meeting with Homeroom Advisors	120 times (each time for at least 15 minutes)
